- At its April meeting, the Board began the process for developing our next **strategic plan** and solicited feedback from the IRPE community at the Annual Community and Member Engagement meeting on April 27th. ## Research and Evaluation

- **Statewide Surveys**
  - **#realcollege Basic Needs Survey**
    - The survey recently closed, with responses from over 80,000 students. Results will be made available later this summer.
  - **Common Course Numbering (CCN) Survey to Districts**
    - The statewide survey to district instruction/academic leads to understand which districts currently have a common course numbering system and how it is structured was administered in March and closed in April. Preliminary results reflected 11 out of 24 multi-college districts having some form of CCN.
  - **Allied Health Program Pathways**
    - A statewide survey to Allied Health program administrators to understand how Allied Health programs are structured, funded, and supported. The survey will be launching summer 2023.
  - **NEW! The College Attendance Survey will be launching again this summer/fall 2023**

## Professional Development

- **We were excited to be back fully in person at RP Conference 2023!** Thank you to those of you who attended! It was so wonderful to see you there.
  - The following provides a breakdown of 215 total attendees:
    - Research Analysts/Specialists were the most represented position with **45%** of our attendees.
    - Deans, Directors, and Vice Presidents made up **35%** of our attendees.
    - The remaining **20%** of attendees were faculty, program coordinators, counselors, IT professionals, consultants, career education personnel, students, and campus executives.
    - There were **75 presenters** (including 1 student), who presented 29 breakout presentations + 4 poster sessions.
    - **62** attended the conference for the first time.
    - **78** colleges and districts were represented.
    - **14** other higher education institutions and companies related to student success products or services.
  - We also had the opportunity to share our [Land Acknowledgment](#) publicly for the first time. We were pleased to be able to recognize the work of Chabot College with their Native American partners and students.
