Quick Updates

- New acronyms
 - ISMC = Intersegmental MC
 - CCCMC = Intrasegmental MC
- Timeline for CCCCO Templates
 - September 1, February 1
- TMCs expected soon:
 - Nutrition/dietetics
 - Child and Adolescent Development
- Interim Dean in Academic Affairs at CCCCO!

SB 440 (Padilla, 2013)

- New mandates for CCCs
 - BoG degree ADT development goals – Spring 2014
 - SB 440 mandates – Spring 2015
- ADT = Associate Degree for Transfer
- AOE = Area of Emphasis
 - Like a major, but broader.

SB 440 (Padilla, 2013)

- Beginning fall 2013:
 - Every CCC shall create an ADT in every major/AOE for which there is a TMC **AND THEY HAVE A DEGREE IN THAT DISCIPLINE** within 18 months of the “approval” of the TMC.
- Before the end of spring 2015:
 - Every CCC shall create an ADT in every major/~~AOE~~ for which there is a TMC finalized prior to fall 2013 **AND THEY HAVE A DEGREE IN THAT DISCIPLINE**.
 - Two TMCs in AOE's will be developed.

BoG AND 440

- Each college has committed to the BoG that they will develop X degrees by the end of spring 2014
- 440 adds a mandate for the development of additional degrees by the end of spring 2015
 - For all disciplines for which there was a TMC in place prior to fall 2013 – if you have a degree in the discipline, you will create an ADT
 - BoG goals allowed for “pollution credits”
 - SB 440 does not!

ICW Working Definition

- An AoE is an interdisciplinary TMC that is developed to serve multiple majors at the CSU.
- Originating department at CCC may be unclear.
- Exploring:
 - Allied Health/Health Science
 - Ethnic Studies
 - STEM/General Science
 - Global studies/international relations

Issues with mandate...

- Workload
- Interference with local control of curriculum
- Unable to develop some ADTs due to:
 - Inability to develop and/or offer a course(s)
 - low enrollment, expensive to offer
 - lack faculty expertise
 - Unit limits – student must be able to complete degree in 60 units

Potential CCC response to ADT mandates?

- Drop existing degrees?
- Rename existing degrees?
- Develop new or (re-purpose old) mechanisms to enable colleges to offer degrees?
 - CVC
 - Re-purpose/rename “conjoint programs” to Collaborative Programs

“Collaborative Programs”

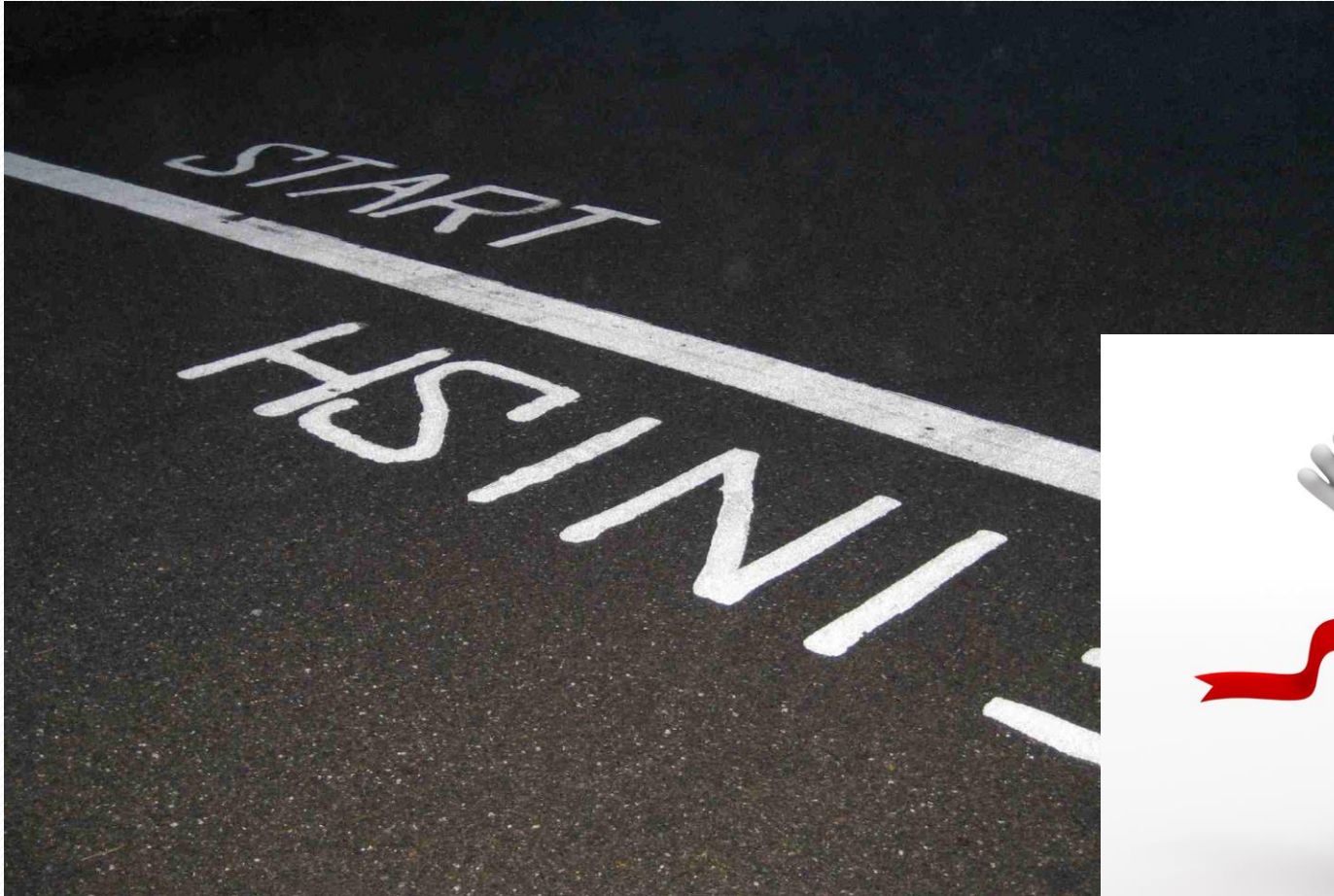
- TMCs establish the shared curriculum required for “conjoint programs”
- Between colleges – intra or inter districts
- Survey coming from the CO
- Policy statement and guidelines forthcoming



AoE TMCs

- Establish listservs to recruit faculty and/or use existing appropriate distribution lists
- Convene Discipline Input Group
- Convene Faculty Discipline Review group
- Vet products
 - TOP Code must be indicated during vetting
- AoE Criteria
 - Minimum number of CSU majors deeming TMC similar?
 - Minimum number of students served?

When are we “done”?



“Done” criteria?

- Ensuring that all disciplines that have ≥ 200 transfer students have been addressed.
 - Must be some element of consistency across CSU campuses.
 - Minimum number of CSUs with major
- Should the goal be to have an ADT pathway for all students?

Descriptor and TMC Review

- 5-year review process for descriptors already developed
 - Initiate process year 4
 - Invite comment
 - CORs MAY need to be submitted
- TMC review – process to be developed
