Stand-Alone Courses

- Local Authority to approve stand-alone courses ended on Jan. 1, 2014.
- These courses now require CCCCO review and approval.

In Curriculum Inventory they are identified by CB 24: Course Program Status = 2 (not program applicable).

Stand-Alone Course Review

- Between Jan. 1 Mar. 15, a total of 779
 courses were approved via the online stand alone approval process
- These will retain limited approval for the 2014-15 Academic Year
- These will also require review and approval by the CCCCO

Stand-Alone Course Verification

- All 779 stand-alone courses will be reviewed by the CCCCO
- If the course does not meet the requirements of title 5, then the CCCCO will contact the college
- By December 31, 2014, if your colleges has not been contacted, the course will retain it's approval

Progress on the ADT 100% Goal

- Background:
 - By Fall 2014, each college will have ADTs in 100% of the majors they offer in which there is a TMC.
 (BOG adopted goal, May 2012)
 - Each college committed to developing ADTs on their AA-T & AS-T 100% Goal Certification Form (Submitted to the CCCCO Jan. 2013)





New Radio Button for ADTs




- Added in May 2014
- Defaulted to "No" for:
 - All previously approved
 ADTs
 - ADT proposals in the queue prior to May 2014
- Proposals found to have "Yes" selected but do not appear in C-ID will be returned to the college

Previously Established Timeline for ADTs


- November 30, 2012
 - Replace the use of
- January 1, 2013
- June 1, 2013

- June 1
 - Any approved ADT that includes courses without an award pending or final C-ID status will be deactivated



C-ID Verification for ADTs

- By June 30, 2015, all courses with C-ID descriptors on any new or previously approved ADT must have an "approved" status in C-ID.
- Effective July 1, 2015, ADTs that do not meet C-ID verification requirement will be deactivated by the CCCCO.



REVISED TIMELINE: All courses for which C-ID descriptors are available must have an "Approved" status by June 30, 2015.



Collaborative Programs

- In conjunction with SACC, CCCCO conducted a survey on the interest in and practice of collaborative programs
- 31 responses were received
- 75% of the respondents were interested in CTE-related collaborative programs
- Discussions related apportionment and which college(s) get credit for completion continue
